Dear Friend,

We are to walk in the divine blessings of God as His children. The Word of God will transform itself and become whatever I need, whenever I need it. As the King’s children, we should proclaim the Word of God over our lives and believe the transforming power it holds is intended for His children because we are worthy of it, not because of what we have done, but because of what was done for us at the Cross.

This letter is designed to help you:

- (B) Learn how to proclaim God’s Word over your life.

#### God’s Unmerited Favor

I ask you to take a short walk with me through the pages of the Bible and witness how God’s favor encompasses His children. In the next few moments, I want you to set your mind to receive the favor of God over every situation and circumstance of your life.

#### Salvation, Prosperity and Joy

“Remember me, O LORD, with the favour that thou bearest unto thy people: O visit me with thy salvation; That I may see the good of thy chosen, that I may rejoice in the gladness of thy nation, that I may glory with thine inheritance.” Psalm 106:4-5

#### Supernatural Increase and Promotion

“For I will have respect unto you, and make you fruitful, and multiply you, and establish my covenant with you.” Leviticus 26:9

#### Restoration Of Everything The Enemy Has Stolen From You

“He prays to God and finds favor with Him, he sees God’s face and shouts for joy; he is restored by God to his righteous state.”

#### Honor In The Midst Of Your Adversaries

“And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.” Exodus 11:3

#### Increased Assets

“And of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with favour, and full with the blessing of the LORD: possess thou the west and the south.” Deuteronomy 33:23

#### Great Victories In The Midst Of Impossible Odds

“<sup>15</sup>And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's. <sup>29</sup>And the fear of God was on all the kingdoms of those countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel.” 2 Chronicles 20:15,29

“And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.” Esther 2:17

“If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do tomorrow as the king hath said.” Esther 5:8

#### Policies, Rules, Regulations And Laws Changed For Your Behalf

“If it please the king, and if I have favour in his sight, and the thing seem right before the king, and I be pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which are in all the king's provinces:” Esther 8:5

#### Territory Gained For Your Behalf Through God’s Intervention

“For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.” Psalm 44:3 We have read the Word of the Lord. ### The Proclamation of Favor

King David said, "But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee. For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield." Psalm 5:11-12

It is important to proclaim the favor of the Lord over our lives, therefore, begin with this proclamation inspired from the promises in His Word:



The favor of God is upon me, His favor goes before me and, therefore, my life will never be the same again. Amen.

We have just proclaimed what many of us never thought possible over our lives. It is time we begin to live in the inheritance of our Heavenly Father has so freely given us. The Word of God says He has never seen the righteous forsaken or their see begging for bread (Psalm 37:25).

The Word says God gives us the power to get wealth (Deut. 8:18). Yet we continue to live outside of our inheritance.

It is time to claim our birthright! We are children of the King. We must begin to believe we are entitled to His provision and favor. We must begin to think and live our lives like children of the King.
